It's time to think football. Register early to keep your roster spot. Teams will start closing in June. Our **registration fee is \$137 (due at Equipment Issue in August) for all grades.** The fee includes use of the League's protective gear (helmet, shoulder pads, jersey, pants, etc.), a mouth-guard, and photo sports pack (individual and team pictures). Upon equipment issue, each player will receive raffle tickets that sell for \$3.00 each, and the player keeps the money. The raffle drawing will be held at the end of the season.
